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SCOPE OF SERVICE AND CARE

Imam Abdulrahman Al Faisal Hospital is a Ministry of Health (MOH) Self Operating Program (SOP) general hospital located in the South of Riyadh City, capital of Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in an area with overcrowded population. Imam Abdulrahman Al Faisal Hospital is a secondary health care organization and currently has a 200-bed capacity. The hospital was opened on 27/11/1433 and serves the population living in the nearby areas. The hospital operates under special legal and ethical environment determined by MOH rules and regulations and following Islamic Laws and Culture that is the characteristic feature of the country. Different categories and types of staff medical and nonmedical are working in the hospital seven different nationalities (Arab and non-Arab, Muslims and non-Muslims). These medical practitioners comply with the rules and regulations of Saudi commission for Health Specialties and Ministry of Health undergoing advance courses outside the hospital i.e. BLS, ACLS and ATLS. The hospital offers prophylactic, diagnostic, and therapeutic services at inpatient and outpatient services to male and female of all age groups, races nationalities and 24 hours round the clock services through Emergency Department.

Hospital services will be resumed in relation to the Hospital's Continuity Plan and in accordance to the number of COVID-19 cases. Distribution of beds may vary according to the number of COVID-19 cases.
